Michael Amaladoss SJ, Dr. theol. habil., b. 1936, was Professor of Systematic Theology at the Vidyajyoti Institute of Religious Studies in New Delhi, Director at the Institute for Dialogue with Cultures and Religions in Chennai (India) and President of the International Association of Mission Studies (IAMS).

Michael Huhn, b. 1956, has worked for Adveniat since 1994 as a desk officer and head of the project department. Since 2008 he has been librarian and archivist of the Episcopal relief organisation for Latin America.

Wendy M. Louis, b. 1950, is General Secretary of the FABC Office of Laity and Family, where she is in charge of the Women's Desk, Director of the Catholic Education Department in the Archdiocese of Singapore and a Member of the Board of Directors of Caritas Singapore.

Frederic Ntedika Mvumbi, Dr. theol., b. 1964, heads the Department of Religious Studies at the Catholic University of Eastern Africa (Nairobi) and is closely involved in Islamic-Christian dialogue.

Since 2009 he has been Director of the Universal Church and Mission Institute of the German Bishops' Conference at the Sankt Georgen Graduate School of Philosophy and Theology.

Pius Rutechura, Dr. theol., b. 1956, is a member of the Association of Member Episcopal Conferences in Eastern Africa (AMECEA) and Vice-president of the Catholic University of Eastern Africa (Nairobi).

Francis X. D'Sa SJ, b. 1936, Dr. theol. Dr. h.c., is a retired Professor of Systematic Theology and Indian Religions at the Jnana-Deepa Vidyapeeth in Pune. Numerous visiting professorships.

Anselme Titianma Sanon, Dr. theol., b. 1937, was Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Bobo-Dioulasso (Burkina Faso). He is Chairman of the Theological Commission of SECAM and took part in both African Synods.
