



Guidelines for a research project

By subsidising such projects, the Institute of Missiology of missio e.V. intends to support the development of theology, philosophy and related disciplines in Africa, Asia, Oceania, and Latin America.

1. Conditions

- 1.1 Subsidies for research projects are granted as well for actual scholarship holders who intend to pursue a research project related to their study project as well as for scholars who intend a research project independently of a scholarship.
- 1.2 Subsidies for research projects can only be granted for scholars coming from Africa, Asia, Oceania, or Latin America.
- 1.3 Subsidies for research projects are given for projects which are done at another place or institution than the home university and primarily meant to cover extra costs such as travelling expenses, fees, materials etc.
- 1.4 The research project has to be of special importance for the development of the local Church and her theological and philosophical reflection.
- 1.5 Priority is given to female applicants (lay as well as religious) and to projects that promote or deal with the empowerment of women or address the safeguarding of children or vulnerable adults.

2. Application procedure

- 2.1 The applicant should be the scholar who intends to pursue the project him- or herself. Applications have to be addressed directly to the MWI.
- 3.2 The application has to be submitted via the Offline Client six months before starting the project and contain the following documents/information:
 - The institution responsible for the project
 - The person leading the project (name, address, position, former academic activities)
 - The other persons involved in the project (names, position)
 - A detailed description of the project (contents, schedule, methodology, source material, the overall context)

- Places and institutions the research is planned to be done at and the reasons for having chosen them
- The period of time
- A tentative budget
 - Costs: travelling expenses, fees, material (which?), living costs, other expenses (which?)
 - Income: local contribution, other financial support, other personal income
 - Requested amount
- A letter of recommendation for this application from the local bishop or from an academic institution.
